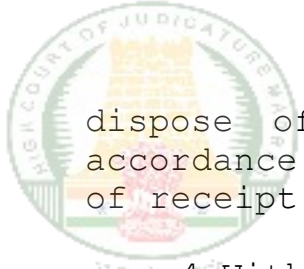
O R D E R

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that it would be suffice, if the T.A.No.344 of 2008 is directed to be disposed of by the first respondent, on merits and in accordance with law, within a time frame to be fixed by this court.

3.In view of the limited scope of the prayer, without going into the merits of the matter, the first respondent is directed to



dispose of the case in T.A.No.344 of 2008 on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the order copy.
