3. By consent, the Writ Petition is taken up for final



disposal at the stage of admission itself.

4.This Writ Petition is filed for granting permission to conduct Jallikattu. The Central Government, keeping in mind the seriousness shown by the people for holding Jallikattu in the State of Tamil Nadu, has passed an ordinance on 31.01.2017. Pursuant thereto, the State Government has enacted the law permitting Jallikattu all over the State of Tamil Nadu and the same has also been Gazetted on 31.01.2017.

5.In view of the above, this Court directs the first respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 18.05.2017 to grant permission forthwith to hold Jallikattu subject to usual conditions, that is being imposed.

6.With the above observations, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
