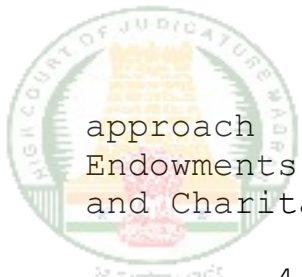

approach the Commissioner, Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowments under Section 65(4) of the Tamilnadu Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowments Act, 1959.
