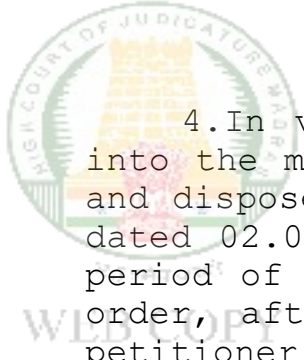

ORDER

In view of the limited scope of the prayer, without going into the merits of the matter, respondent is directed to consider and dispose of the representation of the petitioner's Association, dated 02.05.2017, on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, after providing an opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner.

5. With the above direction, the Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs.
