The petitioner seeks for a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to include petitioner's name in the regular panel for the promotion to the post of superintendent for the year 2017-2018, by considering the representations submitted by the petitioner on 11.08.2016 and 23.05.2017.

2.The learned Additional Government Pleader takes notice for the respondent. By consent, the writ petition itself is taken up for final disposal.

At this stage of hearing, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that it would suffice, if the representations of the petitioner, dated 11.08.2016 and 23.05.2017, are directed to be disposed of, by the respondent, on merits and in accordance with law, within a specified period.

6. With the above direction, the Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs.
