Therefore, without expressing any view on the claim made by the petitioner, this writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file an appeal before the competent appellate authority within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. If any



such appeal is filed, the appellate authority shall consider the same and pass orders, on its own merits and in accordance with law, after hearing the rival claimants, if any. No costs. Consequently, W.M.P(MD)Nos.18079 and 18080 of 2016 are closed.
