Prayer: Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus (i) directing the respondents to extend the 4th and 5th review benefits to the petitioner based on the settlement dated 22.01.2011 entered into under Section 12(3) of Industrial Disputes Act, (ii) to enhance/revise the salary of the petitioner with effect from 01.09.2010 by issuing revised pay fixation order for the promotion to the posts of Senior Checking Inspector and Traffic Inspector in the second respondent Corporation as per G.O.(Ms).No.61 Transport(C) Department, dated 30.04.2015 and consequently (iii) directing the respondents to pay the arrears of difference in salary payable to the petitioner for the period commencing from 01.09.2010 to the date of retirement ie., 31.01.2013 and also to compute and pay revised pension benefits based on the above settlement.
