PRAYER IN CMA (MD) No. 1185 OF 2011: Appeal filed under Section 173 of the Motor Vehicles Act 1988, to set aside the judgment and decree passed in M.C.O.P. No. 614/2002 dated 11/08/2006 on the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal (3rd Additional subordinate Judge), Tiruchirapalli and allow the appeal and thurs render justice.

2. that the Appellant/State Transport Corporation be and hereby is directed to deposit the entire amount with accrued interests and costs within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, if not already deposited and on such deposit being made, the respondent No. 1 injured be and hereby are permitted to withdraw her share with accrued interests and costs; and

3. that there be no costs in this Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.
