O R D E R

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.255 of 2011, pending on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Aranthangi.

2.Though the learned counsel for the petitioner raised several grounds for quashing the proceeding in C.C.No.255 of 2011, he submitted that it would suffice, if a direction is issued to the trial Court to complete the trial within a time limit that may be stipulated by this Court and also to permit the petitioner to raise all the grounds raised in this petition before the trial Court.

3.In the light of the abovesaid submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court without going into the merits of the case, directs the learned Judicial Magistrate, Aranthangi, to complete the trial in C.C.No.255 of 2011, within a period of six months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and the personal appearance of the petitioner is dispensed with unless the learned Magistrate feels that her presence is required for disposal of the case.



4. With the above direction, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
