Prayer in WP(MD). 672/ 2016 :

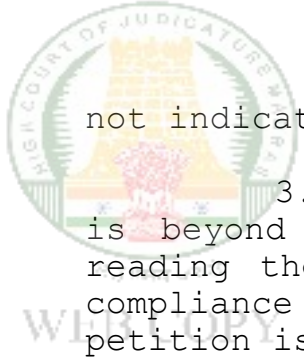
