2.The learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondent submits that in compliance of the order dated 18.09.2014 made in W.P.(MD)No.13493 of 2014, which was confirmed in W.A.(MD) No.1360 of 2015 vide order dated 05.01.2016, proceedings in LrPr.AG (A&E)/Legal Cell/WP(MD)13493/2014/2014-15/2222 dated 09.02.2015 has been produced before this Court and the same is recorded.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner accepts the same and has made an endorsement to that effect. He further submits that liberty may also be given to the petitioner to challenge the order dated 09.02.2015 in appropriate legal proceedings.
