Prayer in WP(MD). 5230/ 2015 :

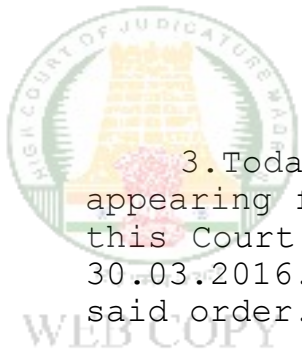

ORDER

This contempt petition is filed complaining that the order passed in the writ petition in W.P(MD)No.5230 of 2015, dated 24.11.2015 is violated.
