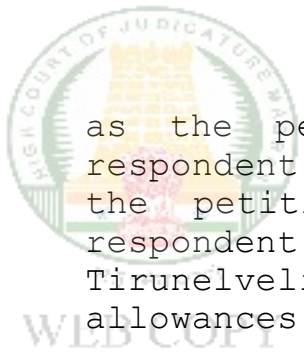
Prayer: Contempt Petition is filed under Section 11 of the Contempt of Courts Act praying this Court to punish the respondent herein for his deliberate and wilful disobedience of the order of this Court dated 22.12.2015 in M.P(MD)No.2 of 2015 in Writ Petition (MD)No.23323 of 2015.

Prayer in MP(MD). 2/ 2015 in WP(MD).23323/2015 :

To grant an Ad Interim Orders directing the 2nd respondent Joint Director to provisionally approve forthwith the appointment of petitioner as Assistant Professor (Zoology) in the 4th respondent college namely, Sarah Tucker College (Autonomous), Tirunelveli, and disburse the grant-in-aid towards her salary and allowances w.e.f. the date of appointment viz., 30.10.2014, within a reasonable time.

Prayer in WP(MD). 23323/ 2015 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court To issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus calling for the records relating to the employment process issued by the 2nd respondent Joint Director in A.Thi.Mu.No.10076/Aa3/2015 dt.14.09.2015, quash the same in so far



as the petitioner is concerned, and further direct the 2nd respondent Joint Director to approve forthwith the appointment of the petitioner as Assistant Professor (Zoology) in the 4th respondent College namely Sarah Tucker College(Autonomous), Tirunelveli and disburse the grant-in-aid towards her salary and allowances w.e.f. the date of her appointment viz., 30/10/2014.
