PRAYER: Petition filed under Section 11 of Contempt of Courts Act, praying to initiate contempt proceedings against the Contemnors/ Respondents and punish him for the willful disobedience of the order of this Court in W.P(MD)No.20932 of 2015 dated 21.01.2016.

Prayer in WP(MD)No.20932/2015 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to settle the retirement benefits of the petitioner including Gratuity the Commuted Value of Pension, Leave Salary with enhanced dearness allowance in term of G.O.Ms No.55 Transport (D) department dated 04.06.2014 together with interest at the rate of 18% per annum from the date of his retirement to till the date of settlement within the time that may be stipulated by this Court and further directing the respondents to pay interest at the rate of 18% per annum for the belated payment of the Provident Fund and Social Security Schemes arrears within the time limit that may be fixed by this Court.
