Prayer in WP(MD)No.20300 of 2015:

Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the Respondents to settle retirement benefits of the petitioner including Gratuity, the Commuted Value of Pension, Leave Salary and monthly pension with enhanced dearness allowance at the rate of 100% in terms of G.O.No.55 Finance (Allowances) Department dated 04.06.2014 together with interest at the rate of 18% per annum from the date of his retirement to till the date of settlement within the time that may be stipulated by this Hon'ble Court and further directing the Respondent to pay interest at the rate of 18% per annum for the belated payment of the Provident Fund and Employees Social Protection Scheme arrears within the time that may be stipulated by this Hon'ble Court.
