Prayer: Petition filed under Section 11 of the Contempt of Court Act, 1971, to initiate contempt proceedings against the contemnors/respondents and punish them for the willful disobedience of the order of this court in W.P(MD)No.22331 of 2015, dated 21.01.2016.

Prayer in WP(MD)No.22331 of 2015:-

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to pay all the terminal benefits payable to the petitioner including Salary arrears in terms of settlement under Section 12(3) of the Industrial Disputes Act dated 13.04.2015, Gratuity, the Commuted Value of Pension, Leave Salary with enhanced dearness allowance at the rate of 100% in terms of G.O.(Ms)No.55 Transport (D) Department dated 04.06.2014 and dearness allowance arrears on monthly pension together with interest at the rate of 18% per annum from the date of his retirement to till the date of payment within the time that may be stipulated by this Hon'ble Court.
