Prayer: Petition filed under Section 11 of the Contempt of Court Act, 1971, to initiate contempt proceedings against the contemnors/respondents and punish them for the willful disobedience of the order of this court in W.P(MD)No.20931 of 2015, dated 21.01.2016.

Prayer in WP(MD). 20931/ 2015 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to settle the retirement benefits of the petitioner including Gratuity the Commuted Value of Pension, Leave Salary based on the settlement under Section 12 (3) of the Industrial Act 1947 dated 13.04.2015 together with interest at the rate of 18% per annum from the date of his retirement to till the date of settlement within the time that may be stipulated by this Court and further directing the respondents to pay interest at the rate of 18% per annum for the belated payment of the Provident Fund and Social Security Scheme arrears within the time limit that may be fixed by this Court.
