Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to settle the retirement benefits of the petitioner including Gratuity, Earned Leave Salary with enhanced dearness Allowance at the rate of 90% in terms of Letter (Ms) No. 24 Transport(E) Department dated 20.02.2014 together with interest at the rate of 18% per annum from the date of my retirement to till the date of settlement within the time that may be stipulated by the Court and further directing the Respondents to pay interest at the rate of 18% per annum for the belated payment of the Provident Fund, the commuted value of pension and Cholan



Employees Security Scheme amount within the time that may be fixed by this Hon'ble Court.
