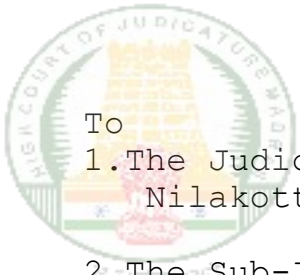
2. In view of the above, the Criminal Original Petition is dismissed as infructuous. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
