When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the learned counsel on either side submitted that the matter has become infructuous and nothing survives in this petition for adjudication.

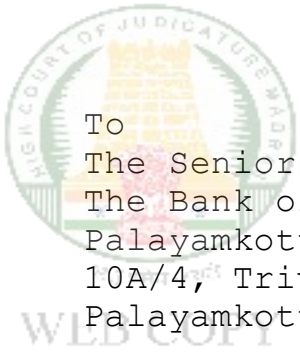
2. Recording such submission, the writ petition is dismissed as infructuous. No costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.
