3.Learned Additional Government Pleader for the respondents 1 and 2 would submit that the petitioner was arrayed as A4 in connection with a case in Crime No.13 of 2011 on the file of the 2nd respondent police and the 2nd respondent, after conducting investigation filed a final report before the Judicial Magistrate, Devakottai, which was taken on file as C.C.No.44 of 2012 and the petitioner was acquitted from the said case after trial on 13.02.2017. It is further submitted that the respondents 1 and 2 have not interfered with the personal liberty of the petitioner.

4.In view of the above submission, this writ petition is dismissed as no further adjudication is necessary. No costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petitions are closed.
