The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is a real estate promoter and as a power agent, he gave a representation before the first respondent against the order of patta transfer by the second respondent. It is further submitted that the petitioner also seeks direction against the police for harassing the petitioner.

3. The learned counsel for the fourth respondent would submit that based on the complaints given by the fourth respondent and other general public, criminal cases were registered against the petitioner and now he is still absconding.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that there is no instructions from the petitioner.

5. In view of the above facts, this writ petition is dismissed. No costs. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
