The petitioner has come up with the present writ petition seeking for issuance of a writ of Mandamus directing the respondents 1 to 4, to implement the recommendation of State Human Rights



Commission, Tamilnadu, which is published in the leading Dailies in Tamilnadu and further direct them to ban the usage of the **"the word 'HUMAN RIGHTS' in the name by any society, Non Governmental Organization (NGO) or association"** within their jurisdictional limits.

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2. Heard Mr.R.R.Thamothar Raj, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.A.Muthukaruppan, learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents 1 to 4.

3. The learned Additional Government Pleader would submit that this writ petition is filed based on the representation dated 15.10.2011 and if the petitioner gives a fresh representation to the respondents 1 and 2, they would take appropriate action.

4. In the light of the above submissions, this Court, without going into the merits of the matter, directs the petitioner to give a fresh representation to the respondents 1 and 2 by enclosing a copy of this order, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. On such compliance, the respondents 1 and 2 shall consider the same and take appropriate action on merits and in accordance with law, after providing an opportunity to all the necessary parties, within a period of eight weeks therefrom.

5. With the above directions, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
