Writ Appeal No.681 of 2017 & W.P.No.12856 of 2017

COMMON ORDER: {Per the Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice Ramesh Ranganathan}

Sri M.Ravindranath Reddy, learned counsel for the respondent-writ petitioner, seeks permission to withdraw W.P.No.12856 of 2017.

W.A.No.681 of 2017 is preferred against the interlocutory order passed in W.P.No.12856 of 2017 dated 13.04.2017. As the learned counsel for the respondent-writ petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the writ petition itself, W.P.No.12856 of 2017 is dismissed as withdrawn. Consequently, the interim order passed therein would no longer survive and the writ appeal has thereby been rendered infructuous. W.A.No.681 of 2017 is, accordingly, dismissed. Miscellaneous Petitions pending, if any, shall also stand dismissed. There shall be no order as to costs.
