

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE T.SUNIL CHOWDARY

CRIMINAL PETITION No.4009 OF 2017

ORDER:

1 This petition is filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C to quash the proceedings against the petitioners in C.C.No.247 of 2016 on the file of the Court of the XIII Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Hyderabad.

2 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor representing the State of Telangana.

3 The only relief, which the learned counsel for the petitioners, has sought is that the presence of the petitioner Nos.2 to 4 /A.2 to A.4 before the trial Court may be dispensed with on each and every date of adjournment. In view of the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, this Court is not inclined to go into the merits of the main case.

4 There is no dispute with the regard to the identity of the petitioners, who are A.2 to A.4 in the case and even if their presence is dispensed with, no prejudice will be caused to the 1st respondent.

5 In view of the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, the presence of the petitioner Nos.2 to 4, who are accused Nos.2 to 4 in C.C.No.247 of 2016 on the file of the Court of the XIII Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Hyderabad is dispensed with on each and every date of adjournment. However, the petitioner Nos.2 to 4 / accused Nos.2 to 4 shall appear before the trial Court as and when their presence is so required.

6 With the above observations, this Criminal Petition is disposed of. As a sequel, the miscellaneous petitions, pending if any in this Criminal Petition, shall stand closed.
