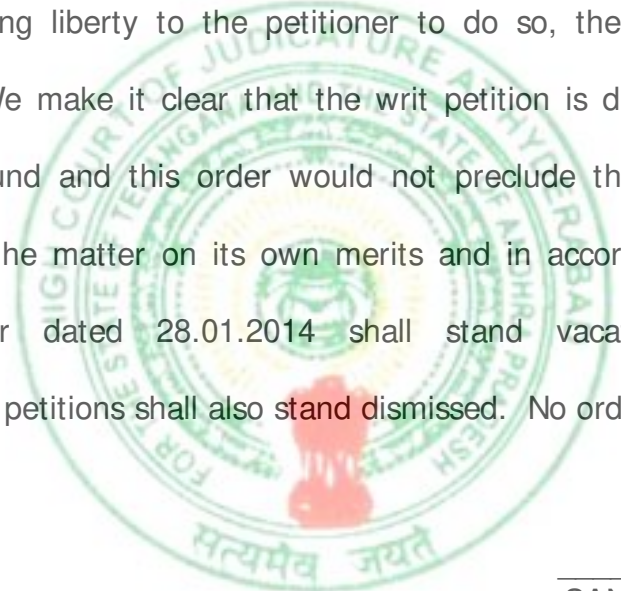
THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE GUDI SEVA SHYAM PRASAD

WRIT PETITION No. 1812 of 2014

ORDER: (per SK, J)

Sri T. Balmohan Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioner-company, would fairly state that in the light of the subsequent developments, the petitioner company would have to avail appropriate remedies before the National Company Law Tribunal, at Hyderabad.

2. Reserving liberty to the petitioner to do so, the writ petition is dismissed. We make it clear that the writ petition is dismissed on this technical ground and this order would not preclude the Tribunal from dealing with the matter on its own merits and in accordance with law. Interim order dated 28.01.2014 shall stand vacated. Pending miscellaneous petitions shall also stand dismissed. No order as to costs.
