JUDGMENT:

The Plaintiff in O.S.No.1866 of 2003 on the file of the VII Senior Civil Judge, City Civil Court, Hyderabad, preferred the present appeal against the judgment and decree dated 08.06.2010, by and underwhich, the Court below, dismissed the suit filed for declaration of title and recovery of possession with mesne profits.

2. During pendency of the appeal, both parties filed the above CCCAMP.No.122/ 2017, stating that they have entered into compromise and settled the matter out of Court amicably and prayed for recording of compromise and dispose of the appeal in terms of the compromise.

3. Both the parties to the appeal are present, and they are identified by their respective counsel.

4. Heard both sides and perused the material on record.

5. Both the parties have admitted the contents, terms and conditions of the compromise, and in proof thereof, affixed their signatures on the compromise petition in open Court. In the Memorandum of compromise it is clearly stated and prayed for the relief of declaration of title in favour of the Appellant/ Plaintiff in respect of the suit schedule property.

6. In that view of the matter, CCCAMP No.122 of 2017 is allowed and the compromise is recorded. Consequently, the

appeal is disposed of in terms of the compromise. No order as to costs. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed in consequence.
