**ORDER:** (*Per VRS,J*)

Aggrieved by their non-appointment to the post of Examiner, pursuant to a recruitment undertaken by the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent, the petitioners have come up with the above writ petition.

2. Heard Mr. K. R. Srinivas, learned counsel for the petitioners. Smt. Bobba Vijayalakshmi, learned standing counsel for the High Court, takes notice for the respondents 1 and 2.

The learned standing counsel passed on a notice, dated 18.03.2017, issued by the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent cancelling the entire process of selection, as per the High Court's letter, dated 14.03.2017. Since the entire process of selection has been cancelled, no individual relief can be granted to the petitioners. Hence, the Writ Petition is dismissed.

Consequently, miscellaneous petitions if any pending in the writ petition shall stand dismissed. No order as to costs.

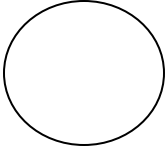
