THE HON'BLE SMT JUSTICE T.RAJANI**

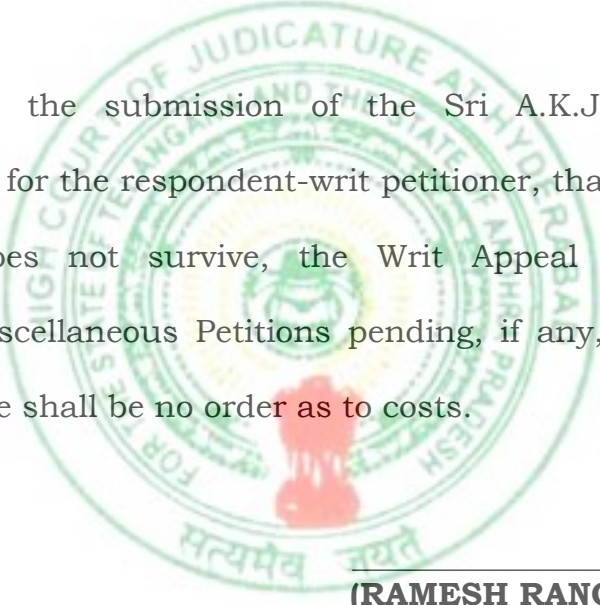
Writ Appeal No.1330 of 2009

JUDGMENT: {Per the Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice Ramesh Ranganathan}

Sri A.K.Jayaprakash Rao, learned counsel for the respondent-writ petitioner, submits that since all the terminal benefits have been paid to the workman, the cause in the writ appeal does not survive.

Sri Ch.Koteswara Rao, learned counsel for the appellant, would submit that it would suffice if the submission of the learned counsel for the respondent-writ petitioner is recorded and the writ appeal is disposed of.

Recording the submission of the Sri A.K.Jayaprakash Rao, learned counsel for the respondent-writ petitioner, that the cause in the writ appeal does not survive, the Writ Appeal is dismissed as infructuous. Miscellaneous Petitions pending, if any, shall also stand dismissed. There shall be no order as to costs.
