This court made the following :

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COMMON ORDER :

When the matters are taken up for consideration learned Special Standing counsel fairly submits that no reasons are assigned by the three-man committee appointed and similar issue was considered by this Court in W.P.No.41245 of 2016 & batch. By common order dated 02.02.2017, this Court set aside the consequential order of the District Collector and remitted the matters to the three-man committee for consideration of the issue afresh.

2. Both the counsel admitted that the subject matter of the writ petitions are covered by the said order. The operative portion of the order reads as under:

“21. Thus, the writ petitions are allowed. The matters are remitted to the stage of consideration by the three-man Committee. The Committee shall assign due reasons in support of its recommendation on each of the petitioners after consideration of the explanations already submitted and on due verification of the relevant records. It shall forward its recommendations to the Project Directors concerned. On consideration of such recommendations, the respective Project Directors shall pass orders as required in each of the cases. The entire exercise shall be completed within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

22. Since the matters are remitted to the stage of consideration of three-man committee constituted as directed by this Court in Para No.111 in W.P.No.27468 of 2015 and batch dated 31.12.2015, as directed in Para 112, till the decision is made in accordance with

the directions issued in these batch of writ petitions, no further appointments shall be made at the places earlier occupied by petitioners.”

3. Following the said order and the reasons assigned therein, these writ petitions are also allowed and the matters are remitted to the stage of consideration of the issue by the three-man committee appointed in pursuant to the directions issued by this Court in W.P.No.27468 of 2015 & batch. There shall be no order as to costs.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in these writ petitions shall stand closed.
