

HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE S.V.BHATT

WRIT PETITION No.6141 of 2013

ORDER:

Heard Sri A.S.Vasudevan for petitioner and the Assistant Government Pleaders for Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.

The petitioner prays for the following relief :-

“..... to issue a Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the 3rd respondent in summoning the petitioner to CID Office and threatening to implicate him in false criminal cases without there being any sort of complaint or case registered against him, and thereby causing interference with the personal life and liberty of the petitioner, as being illegal, arbitrary and in violation of Article 21 of the Constitution of India, to grant such other relief or reliefs as this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper.....”

The Assistant Government Pleaders representing respondents, on instructions, submit that a few complaints are received against HIM Trust, these registered complaints are transferred to special investigation team and in that connection, in one of the cases, the petitioner was arrested and enlarged on bail. The petitioner is one of the accused in the crimes registered against Money Circulation Racket. Therefore, it is stated that for this cause and in accordance with law, the petitioner is summoned to police station.

Learned counsel for petitioner does not have latest instructions.

Having regard to the statement made by the learned Assistant Government Pleaders, I am satisfied that no ground is made out for exercising the discretion of this Court or grant general prayer to petitioner.

The writ petition fails and is accordingly dismissed. No costs.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending, shall stand closed.
