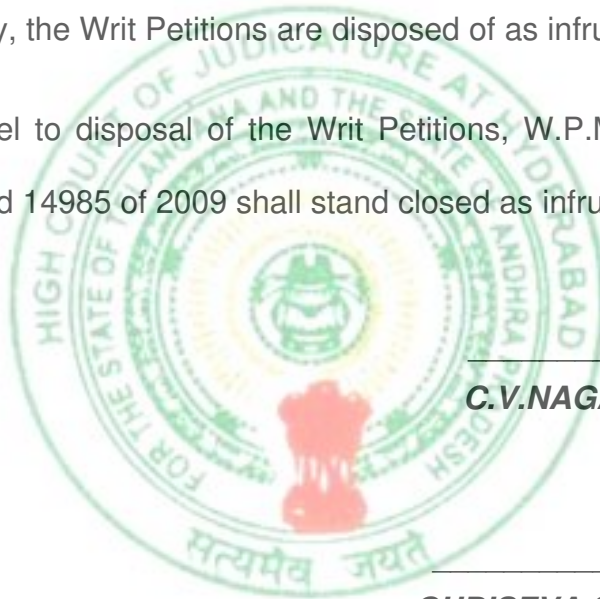
COMMON ORDER: (per Hon'ble Sri Justice C.V.Nagarjuna Reddy)

These Writ Petitions are filed against *interim* orders passed by the Andhra Pradesh Administrative Tribunal at Hyderabad (for short, 'the Tribunal') pending the O.As.

2. At the hearing, Sri D.Linga Rao, learned counsel for the petitioners, submitted that during pendency of these Writ Petitions, final orders have been passed by the Tribunal in the O.As. and that therefore the said O.As., having been finally disposed of, rendered the cause in these Writ Petitions infructuous.

3. Accordingly, the Writ Petitions are disposed of as infructuous.

4. As a sequel to disposal of the Writ Petitions, W.P.M.P.Nos. 25762 and 25775 of 2002 and 14985 of 2009 shall stand closed as infructuous.
