ORDER: (Per Hon'ble Sri Justice V. Ramasubramanian)

The dealer under the APGST Act has come up with the present writ petition challenging the inaction on the part of the respondents in not considering their representations in relation to TDS certificates issued by a State owned Corporation.

2. Heard Mr. Shaik Jeelani Basha, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. J. Anil Kumar, learned Special Standing Counsel for the Department of Commercial Taxes (Telangana).

3. The issue raised in this writ petition relating to the assessment year 2001-2002, is actually covered by a decision of a Division Bench of this Court relating to the assessment year 2002-2003, in W.P.No.8295 of 2009, dated 02.01.2017. Therefore, following the same, this writ petition is also disposed of directing the respondents to consider the representations of the petitioner for the year 2001-2002, give them the benefit of TDS deducted from their bills for the said period and issue a demand notice afresh in accordance with law.

4. As a sequel, pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.
