JUDGMENT:

The Defendant in O.S.No.83 of 2006 on the file of the III Additional Chief Judge, City Civil Court, Hyderabad, preferred the present appeal against the judgment and decree dated 22.04.2008, by and under which, the Court below, decreed the suit.

2. During pendency of the appeal, both parties filed the above CCCAMP.No.503 of 2016, stating that they have entered into compromise and settled the matter out of Court amicably and prayed for recording of compromise and dispose of the appeal in terms of the compromise.

3. Both the parties to the appeal are present, and they are identified by their respective counsel.

4. Heard both sides and perused the material on record.

5. As per the compromise it is clear that all the three parties, who are mother, son and daughter, have amicably settled the matter and divided the property into three equal shares. The contents of the affidavit read over and explained to them, and the parties have admitted the contents, terms and conditions of the compromise, and in proof thereof, affixed their signatures on the compromise petition in open Court. The parties prayed for recording the memorandum of compromise and dispose of the appeal accordingly.

6. In that view of the matter, CCCAMP No. 503 of 2016 is allowed and the compromise is recorded. Consequently, the appeal is disposed of in terms of the compromise. No order as to costs. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed in consequence.
