CRIMINAL PETITION No.5884 OF 2016

ORDER:

Sri M.A.K. Mukheed, learned counsel for the petitioner – accused, is present.

2. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State of Telangana would submit that on filing of Charge Sheet, the XVI Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Nampally, has taken cognizance of the offences in C.C.No.152 of 2014, which is presently transferred to III Special Metropolitan Magistrate, Erramanzil, and numbered as C.C.No.3 of 2016, and, therefore, the present Criminal Petition becomes infructuous.

3. In view of the submission made by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, the Criminal Petition is dismissed as infructuous. It is needless to mention that the petitioner is at liberty to move appropriate application.
