

HON' BLE SRI JUSTICE C. PRAVEEN KUMAR

WRIT PETITION No. 1261 of 2017

ORDER:

- 1) Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and Government Pleader for Revenue. With consent of both the parties, the main writ petition is being taken up for disposal at the admission stage itself.
- 2) The present writ petition came to be filed seeking issuance of writ of mandamus directing the action of respondent Nos.2 and 3 in interfering with the house property of the petitioner covered by Door No.9-8-109/ A/ 110, Kumariwadi Chota Bazar, Golconda, Hyderabad, without issuing any notice and not removing the notice board despite the representations of the petitioner, as illegal, arbitrary and violative of principles of natural justice; and consequently direct the respondents not to interfere with the petitioner's property.
- 3) Though various grounds are raised in the writ petition, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer seeking a direction to the second respondent to consider his representation dated 17.11.2016.
- 4) The Government Pleader for Revenue submits that if the said application is still pending consideration, the authorities may be directed to consider the said representation in accordance with law.

5) Without going into the merits of the case and having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of, directing the second respondent to dispose of the representation dated 17.11.2016, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of eight to twelve weeks from the date of receipt of the order, if the same is made and still pending consideration. No order as to costs.

6) Consequently, miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this Writ Petition shall stand closed.
