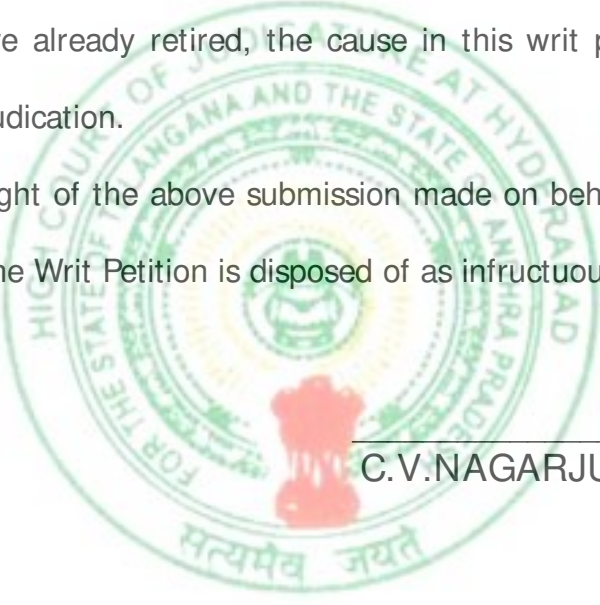
WRIT PETITION No.7918 of 2004

ORDER: (per Hon'ble Sri Justice C.V.Nagarjuna Reddy)

This writ petition is filed for a mandamus to set aside the order, dated 30.04.2003, in O.A.No.3353 of 1996, on the file of the Andhra Pradesh Administrative Tribunal at Hyderabad (for short "the Tribunal").

At the hearing, it is submitted by the learned counsel for private respondents that since the dispute pertains to *inter se* seniority and all the employees have already retired, the cause in this writ petition does not survive for adjudication.
