JUDGMENT:

The present appeal is filed aggrieved by the judgment and decree dated 30-09-2010 passed in O.S.No.3/2006 by the VIII Additional Senior Civil Judge (FTC), City Civil Court, Hyderabad.

2. Now, both the parties, having settled the matter, moved C.C.C.A.M.P.No.755 of 2016 seeking to pass a decree in terms of the memorandum of compromise. The Memorandum of compromise has been placed on record.
