Both these writ petitions arise out of the orders passed by the Additional Commissioner (Commercial Taxes), granting a stay of the collection of the disputed tax, upon payment of 50% of the disputed tax.

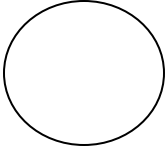
2. However, it is stated by Mr. S. Ravi, learned senior counsel for the petitioner, that the original order of assessment itself has been set aside on a regular appeal.
