

HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE A.RAJASHEKER REDDY

WRIT PETITION No.9003 OF 2017

ORDER:

The petitioner challenged the proceedings in Rc.B/66/2016, dated 19-01-2017 of the Tahsildar, wherein her application for mutation is rejected stating that after sub-division of subject land, mutation and E-Passbook will be granted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already made application for sub-division of patta by paying necessary fee. Without first considering the said application, the respondent-authorities have refused the application for mutation. He also relied on the judgment of **A.Krishna Reddy v. Tahsildar, Shamshabad Mandal, Ranga Reddy¹**.

Heard learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue.

When the petitioner has filed application for sub-division of patta, the 3rd respondent should have taken that application at first and after considering the same, the 3rd respondent should have considered the application filed in Form VI-A for mutation of her name.

In view of the same, impugned order is set aside. The 3rd respondent is directed to take-up the application of the petitioner for sub-division of patta at first and thereafter

consider the application of the petitioner for mutation. The said exercise shall be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of. As a sequel to the disposal of this petition, miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending shall stand closed.
