Aggrieved by their non-appointment to the post of Field Assistant, pursuant to a recruitment undertaken by the 1st respondent, the petitioners have come up with the above writ petition.

2. Heard Mr. R. Satyanarayana Murthy, learned counsel for the petitioners. Smt. Bobba Vijayalakshmi, learned standing counsel for the High Court, takes notice for the respondents 1 and 2.

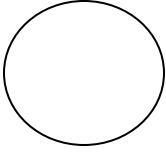
3. The learned standing counsel passed on a notice, dated 18.03.2017, issued by the 1st respondent cancelling the entire process of selection, as per the High Court's letter, dated 14.03.2017. Consequently, miscellaneous petitions if any pending in the writ petition shall stand dismissed. No order as to costs.
