At the appellate stage, Sri J.C.Francis, learned counsel for the appellant, seeks permission to withdraw the Writ Petition itself.

By the order under appeal, the Writ Petition was disposed of directing the Station House Officer to comply with Section 41-A of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Learned Government Pleader for Home expresses no objection to the petitioner withdrawing the Writ Petition.
