

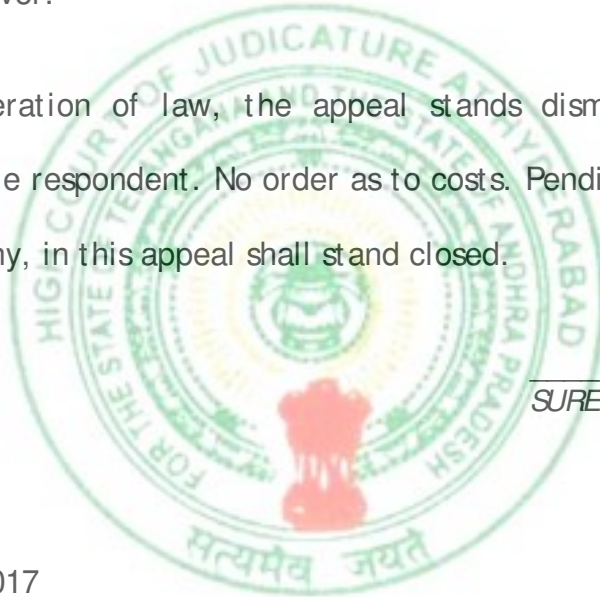

JUDGMENT (oral): (*per Suresh Kumar Kait, J*)

It is evident from the order dated 19.06.2017 that the sole respondent died and the learned Government Pleader sought adjournment for bringing the legal representatives of the deceased respondent on record. However, no steps have been taken to bring the legal representatives of the deceased-respondent on record, despite 90 days already over.

By operation of law, the appeal stands dismissed as abated against the sole respondent. No order as to costs. Pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, in this appeal shall stand closed.
