ORDER:

This writ petition is filed for the following substantive relief:

“..to issue an appropriate Writ, order or direction, in the nature of Mandamus, declaring the order passed by the 1st respondent herein in its proceedings bearing No.E1/32/2007, dated 21.11.2007, transferring the petitioners, as being illegal, arbitrary, capricious and mala fide.”

At the hearing, there is no representation for the petitioners. From the nature of the relief claimed by the petitioners, namely, quashing of transfer order, the grievance of the petitioners might have ceased to survive by efflux of time of more than nine years. Hence, the writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.

As a sequel to disposal of the writ petition, interim order dt.10.12.2007 passed in W.P.M.P. No.34341 of 2007 shall stand vacated and the said application shall stand disposed of as infructuous.
