2. Heard Mr. K. R. Srinivas, learned counsel for the petitioner. Smt. Bobba Vijayalakshmi, learned standing counsel for the High Court, takes notice for the respondents 1 and 2.

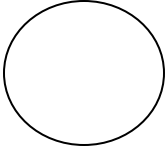
