

THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE RAJA ELANGO

WRIT PETITION No.14873 OF 2009

ORDER:

This writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following relief:-

“to issue a writ, order or direction, more particularly a writ in the nature of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents in trying to assign the lands of the petitioner to an extent of Ac.2.03 gts in Sy.No.20/B, situated at Kanpa Mediguda Village of Jainath Mandal, Adilabad District to third parties by dispossessing the petitioner from his land under the guise of the orders passed by the 2nd respondent in Case No.TWA2/1182/1984, dated 31.3.1998, even though the statutory appeal filed by the petitioner before the 1st respondent is pending as illegal, arbitrary, unjust, violation of principles of natural justice, opposed to equity and fair play and be pleased to set aside the orders passed by the 2nd respondent in Case No.TWA2/1182/1984, dated 31.3.1998 and consequently direct the respondents not to assign the land of the petitioner to an extent of Ac.2.03 gts in Sy.No.20/B, situated at Kanpa Mediguda Village of Jainath Mandal, Adilabad District to others in the interest of justice.”

2. When the matter is taken up for hearing, it is informed by the learned counsel for the petitioner that on 24.07.2009, this Court directed the respondents to maintain *status quo* with regard to possession of the subject land for a period of four weeks from that day and on 26.08.2009, the same was extended until further orders, and requested the Court to direct respondent No.1 herein to dispose of the appeal filed by the petitioner on 03.03.2008 *vide* LTR Appeal No.A4/LTR/8/2008 against the judgment and decree,

dated 31.03.1998, in Case No.T.W.A2/1182/1984 passed by respondent No.2 at an early date.

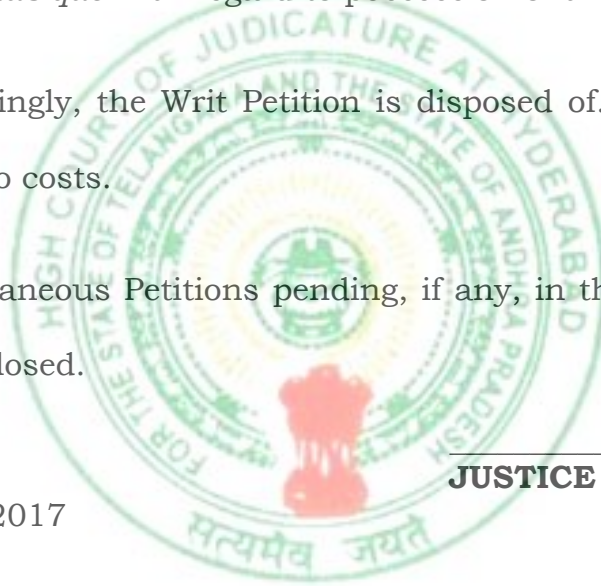
3. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the grievance of the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, respondent No.1 is hereby directed to dispose of LTR Appeal No.A4/LTR/8/2008 filed by the petitioner against the judgment and decree, dated 31.03.1998, in Case No.T.W.A2/1182/1984 passed by respondent No.2 as expeditiously as possible. Till disposal of the said appeal, the respondents are directed to maintain *status quo* with regard to possession of the subject land.

4. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

5. Miscellaneous Petitions pending, if any, in this Writ Petition shall stand closed.
