THE COURT MADE THE FOLLOWING:

ORDER: (per the Hon'ble Sri Justice C.V. Nagarjuna Reddy)

This writ petition is filed for issue of habeas corpus directing the respondents to produce one P.S. Partha Sarathi, S/o.Late P.S. Rao ("the alleged detenu") before this Court and set him free.

At the hearing, learned counsel for both sides submitted that the alleged detenu was arrested, produced before the jurisdictional Magistrate and also released on bail.

In view of the above submission, the cause in the writ petition does not survive for adjudication. The writ petition is accordingly disposed of as infructuous.

As a sequel to disposal of the writ petition, W.P.M.P. Nos.21257 and 21258 of 2017 shall stand disposed of as infructuous.
