

HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE RAJA ELANGO

WRIT PETITION No.635 of 2017

ORDER:

The present writ petition is filed by the petitioner seeking to declare the action of the respondents in calling her to the police station daily, in connection with the civil disputes, as illegal and arbitrary, and consequently, direct the respondents not to call the petitioner to the police station.

Heard and perused the material available on record.

It is stated in the affidavit that the petitioner is a widow and the 6th respondent is her close relative and there are civil disputes pending between them and at the instance of the 6th respondent, the 5th respondent is calling the petitioner to the police station and insisting her to settle the civil disputes with the 6th respondent.

The learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home submitted that the respondent police are not intending to interfere with the civil disputes.

Considering the circumstances of the case, without expressing any opinion on merits, the Writ Petition is disposed of with the following direction:

“The respondents 2 to 5 are directed not to interfere with the affairs of the petitioner and the 6th respondent, more particularly, with the civil disputes pending between them. However, this Order will not stand in the way of the respondents 2 to 5 to register a case, if any complaint is lodged against the petitioner for cognizable offence.”

There shall be no order as to costs. Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this writ petition shall stand closed.
