

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE C.PRAVEEN KUMAR

W.P.NO.19824 OF 2017

ORDER

Alleging that the 3rd respondent – Station House Officer, Chandur Police Station, Naglonda District, in summoning the petitioner to the police station without there being any crime registered against him and threatening to withdraw the suit filed by him in O.S.No.167/2017 on the file of Junior Civil Judge, Nalgonda against the 4th respondent, the present writ petition came to be filed.

The learned Government Pleader for Home, on instructions, while opposing the writ averments, would submit that the respondent No.3 never summoned the petitioner to the police station.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances and the submissions of the learned counsel, without going into the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of at the stage of admission, directing that respondent No.3 not to summon the petitioner to the police station, except following the due process of law.

No order as to costs.

Miscellaneous petitions pending if any, shall stand closed.
