JUDGMENT: (*per the Hon'ble Sri Justice C.V. Nagarjuna Reddy*)

This appeal arises out of order dated 15.02.2010 passed in IA.No.1206 of 2009 in HMOP.No.70 of 2009 whereby the family Court dismissed the petition filed to set aside *ex parte* decree dated 09.07.2009 passed in HMOP.No.70 of 2009 filed for restitution of conjugal rights.

2. Mr. S.V.S. Prasada Rao, learned counsel representing Mr. K.R. Koteswara Rao, learned counsel for the respondent, submitted that the OP filed by the appellant for dissolution of marriage is decreed and that in view of the same, the appeal has become infructuous.

In view of the above submission of the learned counsel, the family Court appeal is dismissed as infructuous.
